Good afternoon,

You are receiving this email because you have previously expressed an interest in Victoria's Container Deposit Scheme, CDS Vic, or Victoria's circular economy policy, *Recycling Victoria: a new Economy*.

I am pleased to let you know that the Victorian Government has appointed organisations to run the scheme. This marks an important milestone for the scheme, which is set to start on 1 November 2023.

CDS Vic, will be a win for Victoria's environment, community and economy. It is expected to create 645 direct jobs and cut litter by up to half.

VicReturn will be the Scheme Coordinator and will manage the financial and administrative aspects of the scheme.

Return-It, TOMRA Cleanaway and Visy will be the Network Operators. They will establish and maintain a network of refund collection points in their appointed zones.

Closer to scheme commencement the Scheme Coordinator and Network Operators will be able to provide more information on how you can participate in the scheme. This includes registering your interest to be:

- a collection point operator, or
- a donation partner.
