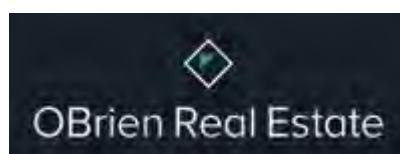

**Great to be greening The Briars and thanks to those involved, C.Stokes**

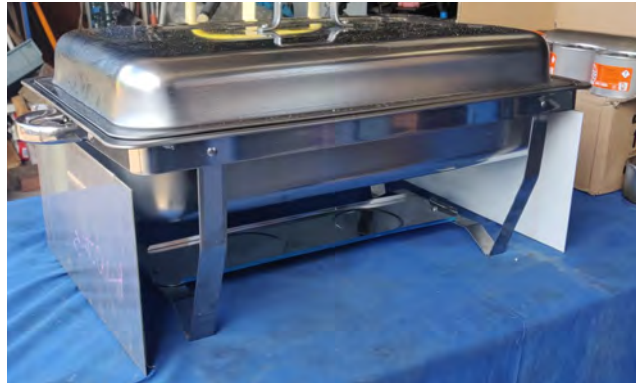
