#### To summarise:

Environment, now the 7th area of service. Rob Davies highlighted that RCMM is dedicated to



protecting the environment and also pro-active in providing environmentally sustainable projects. We consider the environment in everything we say and do. Highlights being Tree planting at The Briars July 2022, reconnected with BERG, and playing our part in Clean up Australia in March 2023. New involvement with Repower Australia, dedicated to de-carbonising our Peninsula, was attended by both Local and State Government representatives.

A date has now been set by the Victorian Government for

the start of the Container Deposit Scheme November 2023. This very exciting project will create connection with schools, sporting and community groups to name a few. The potential to significantly raise funds for our projects is also noted.



International, Ray Martin reminded us of the many disasters and challenges that we have faced this year and as is the case, we did our part in supporting these causes. There will always be more. We have provided funds and support to Rotarians Against Malaria (RAM), Rotary Oceania Medical Aid for Children (ROMAC), Interplast, Provided drinking water solutions and maternity aid to remote areas in Padua New Guinea, Shelterbox, Disaster Aid (Sky Hydrant which purifies otherwise undrinkable water), The School Of St Jude in

Tanzania and many other worthwhile projects.

**Youth,** Pat Morton mentioned that involvement with local schools still remains key. The approach has been "how can we help?" . Highlights include funding to Mornington Park Pri-



mary School in aid of their school camp. New football jumpers to Osborne Primary, we continue to support Mornington Secondary with their Breakfast Club and Valedictory Dinner and families in need. Other projects have included Fusion renovation project, Sleep in YourCar, Mock Interviews at Balcombe Grammar School. Quinn's Place has been a new project where some funds raised through our raffle, have gone to funding and support of this Friday night refuge for youth.


