



## TREASURER BYRON'S MEETING NOTES

Welcome to all our Members, Friends, and Supporters

### Assistant Governor Peter Rawlings

AG Peter commenced his report acknowledging and thanking those in the Club who are assisting at the District level this year, including Gordon Morriss (District Treasurer), Janet Pugh (District Newsletter), Wayne Jenkins (R.O.R.P.), Linda Ferrari (District Public Image Chair), Peter Rawlings (District Conference Chair and Assistant Governor – Peninsula Cluster) and Rob Davies (District Conference). Peter thanked Carol and the Club for their service during the past year and congratulated President Bill on his induction and made mention of the successful District Changeover between PDG Bill Degnan to DG Paul Mee.

Peter then spoke about the upcoming Peninsula Cluster President's Meeting to be held in late July, where President Bill will engage with his counterparts as they are updated on the Peninsula Trail, a proposed Cluster Interplast project, District Conference next February at the Cape Schanck Resort and the Zone 8 Regionalisation. Peter mentioned the regionalisation and the fact that the club will need to vote in order for President Bill to then cast a vote in early September on the proposal. Peter wished the Club well for the year ahead.

### International Director Ray Martin

Ray updated the members on International mentioning;

**RAM -Rotarians Against Malaria** - over 1Million people die each year from Malaria. These funds go towards helping reduce the risk. eg: nets and removing mosquito habitats.

**PNG Fresh Water ORO** - a water project by the RC of Warrnambool that we have supported in past years. This club has also supported us when carrying out our project last year

**Birthing Kits – PNG** - we plan to supply birthing kits to assist in preventing maternal and newborn deaths and infections. We will arrange for a midwife to provide education for their use.

**Clean Water PNG** - this is another project in PNG following our success last year. The idea is to provide water storage and fresh clean drinking water to a village.

**School of St Jude** - we provide financial support to this school for Teacher PD and for a Health and Hygiene program for Girls in Tanzania.

**Shelterbox** - a Rotary project where shelter is provide to people overseas who have been made homeless due to natural on man made disasters.

**Disaster Aid** - a Rotary project where unit are provided to those in need. These units provide fresh drinking water to numerous people.

**ROMAC – Rotary Oceania Medical Aid for Children** - aRotary project where people from overseas are brought to Australia for treatment for difficult to treat medical conditions.

**Interplast** - a project where teams of volunteer plastic surgeons travel to nearby countries to perform surgeries to damaged individuals and train the local surgeons regarding techniques. The funds go towards purchasing supplies.

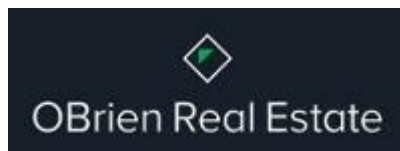
