This year in Review

As we all prepare for the Changeover meeting on Tuesday evening, I have reflected on the "year that was" and how much the world has changed, and I am grateful to have been involved in a really active and supportive club who have made a difference over the last 12 months. Covid has had a significant effect on Rotary this year relating to both projects and fellowship, meetings resumed in February, and we have seen numbers gradually increase over the last few months with Hybrid meetings established to accommodate as many of our members as possible. We were able to upgrade our equipment to ensure that we could continue to offer Zoom facilities as well as being back at the Mornington Hotel.

This first 6 months saw Zoom meetings of around 20 members regularly attending, but minimal social activities due to Covid restrictions with similar numbers face to face once we returned to TMH, although over the last few weeks we have seen more members attending in these cold winter evening.

Over the year we have had many interesting speakers who has contributed to our knowledge of Rotary as well as too our local community.

I revisited the 4 goals I set for this year, some have been more successful than others but overall, I'm proud of the great work all our members and the 2021/22 Board have achieved. And I thank all of you most sincerely for what we have achieved this year and all of you who have contributed to achievement. Too many to name individually and I would hate to leave someone out.

My number 1 aim was to help build our membership, we started the year 42 members, and I had hoped to significantly increase membership, with a strong focus on increasing woman in the Club.

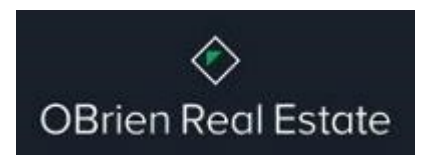
