### **Days of Service**

As part of his 2021- 22 initiative President Shekhar Mehta is encouraging Clubs to plan and host a practical and action orientated Rotary Day of Service. This event should address a challenge facing your community that fits in one or more of the Rotary areas of focus and brings together volunteers from within and outside of Rotary. We're halfway through the Rotary year and many Clubs have already risen to the challenge.

In Japan the Rotary Clubs of Hiroshima Ryohoku and Hiroshima North are working together to organise an event to clean up the Former Otagawa river and riverbank. In total 70 people participated including family members and local alumni associations.

In the Philippines the Rotary Clubs of Narvacan partnered with the Rotary Club of Makati and have joined together with their District to provide food and essential supplies to support community members affected by the flash flooding due to the tropical storm Maring.

In Nigeria the Rotaract Club of Owerri Metropolitan has conducted free hepatitis tests for over 250 people in Orji market in commemoration of World Hepatitis Day.

In Turkey some of the Clubs of organised beach clean-ups and also invited general public to participate. These are just some of the events that have happened or are happening all over the world.

Good morning everyone

This morning we had another very good meeting with Council staff ...

Good things are continuing to happen

- Councillors have included the Peninsula Trail in their top 6 priorities for the Federal election candidates, and our now meeting them, to discuss it.
- The results of the application to the Victorian Growing Suburbs Fund for the Baxter to Somerville section is likely to be known shortly. Success will mean it can start this year. If not successful it goes up the list of priorities for next year.
- The application to the Victorian Regional Tourism Fund for the Mornington to Moorooduc and Southern
  Peninsula sections will not be known until June. The best thing we can all be doing now is talking to State MP's
  about supporting it.
- Council has updated their website to provide very good information including maps and videos about what the
  whole project is about, and references it as our Centenary Project. See

- Don't forget Council has committed \$10m and we just need to help them find the rest!

### In terms of individual club projects

- MtMartha is the clear leader! Well done! They are well advanced in installing rest stop furniture on the Trail between Craigie Road and the Briars
- Dromana is also well progressed, having submitted the appropriate application form for their upgraded rest stop near the coffee van at Safety Beach. The quote for it is higher than expected so they are pursuing Grant funding including the Council Place Making Grant I emailed you about earlier this week.
- Sorrento have submitted the Application Form and are reviewing their exact location after some issue with the proposed one.
- Nothing much more has been heard from the other clubs and none are known to have submitted the required Community Infrastructure Form. Any updates would be appreciated.
- Council is working on a pilot signage project and considering 4 locations for it. Mornington indicated a
  willingness to contribute to this for the Civic Reserve to Mt.Martha/Briars section.


